OMBRE SAMPLER COWL

This is a simple design, suitable for knitters of all levels, including beginners, using panels of stocking, seed and garter stitch with a beautiful blended yarn effect.

The scarf has a generous width and is long enough to wrap around the neck a couple of times.

MATERIALS

Yarn quality: John Arbon Knit by Numbers 4ply organically farmed Falklands Merino hanks.

Shades used: KBN 84, KBN 08, KBN 12, KBN 06, KBN 03

Wind each colour into two balls

Needles & Notions

5.00mm US8

darning needle

scissors

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

166cm X 35cm

STITCHES USED

Stocking stitch (alternative rows of plain and purl stitches)

Seed stitch (working 1 knit stitch and 1 purl stitch across a row, then they are alternated every other row by knitting the purl stitches and purling the knit stitches)

Garter stitch (purl stitches on every row)

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Handwash at low temperature with mild detergent or wool wash

INSTRUCTIONS

ABBREVIATIONS

ST ST- STOCKING STITCH

R ST ST- REVERSE STOCKING STITCH

SE ST- SEED STITCH

GA ST- GARTER STITCH

MAKE

CAST ON 67 STITCHES USING 5MM US 8

NEEDLES 1 END KBN 84 & 1 END KBN 06

1ST ROW: KNIT 3 GA ST, 20 ST ST, 21 SE ST,
20 ST ST, 3 GA ST

2ND ROW: KNIT 3 GA ST, 20 R ST ST, 21 SE
ST, 20 R ST ST, 3 GA ST

*THESE 2 ROWS FORM PATTERN.

CONTINUE IN PATTERN

KNIT 36 ROWS THEN CHANGE YARN.

KNIT 48 ROWS 2 ENDS KBN 08.

KNIT 36 ROWS 1 END KBN 08 & 1 END KBN 84

KNIT 48 ROWS 2 ENDS KBN 84

KNIT 36 ROWS 1 END KBN 84 & 1 END KBN 12

KNIT 48 ROWS 2 ENDS KBN 12

KNIT 36 ROWS 1 END KBN 12 & 1 END KBN 03

KNIT 48 ROWS 2 ENDS KBN 03

KNIT 36 ROWS 1 END KBN 03 & 1 END KBN 06

KNIT 48 ROWS 2 ENDS KBN 06

CAST OFF

PIN OUT TO MEASUREMENTS, COVER WITH A
CLEAN DAMP CLOTH AND LEAVE TO DRY
NATURALLY.

WHEN DRY JOIN THE TWO ENDS TOGETHER
USING MATTRESS STITCH FORMING A LOOP.
