


NEW BORN PUPPY PATTERN



MATERIALS

YARN My yarn choices, the brand and shades I used, are italicized:

Yarn A BROWN 4-PLY YARN I used a tiny amount Drops Nord shade 22 Chestnut

Yarn B LIGHT LAVENDER 4-PLY YARN I used less than half ball Katia Soft Gratté shade 67 Stone Grey

(or sub. with Drops Alpaca shade 12 with yarn C)

Yarn C OFF-WHITE MOHAIR I used 1 25g ball Drops Kid-Silk shade 01

Yarn D WHITE 4-PLY YARN I used 1 50g ball Drops Baby Alpaca Silk shade 1101 White

(or sub. with Drops Alpaca shade 1101 White)

Yarn E RUST-BROWN MOHAIR I used 1 25g ball Drops Kid-Silk shade 33 Rust

PLUS 5 lengths of Yarn F BROWN MOHAIR I used 5 x 70cm (approx.) lengths taken from 25g ball Drops Kid-Silk shade 35 Chocolate

KNITTING NEEDLES

Pair of 3.50mm single point knitting needles - I use LYKKE Driftwood 25cm length ones

You'll also need a 3.50mm circular knitting needle - this is just for holding stitches and you'll be directed when and how to use it in the pattern

GAUGE

18-19 rows and 13-14 stitches over 5cm (2in) with 3.50mm needles

TOY FILLING

I use uncarded toy filling out of preference which you can purchase from here - Ebay.co.uk and

here mohairbearmakingsupplies.co.uk

EXTRAS

Pair 10mm, brown, toy safety eyes with washer backs (not suitable for children under 3 years old), Scissors and yarn-sewing needle, 28 coloured stitch markers (see page 3)

FINISHED SIZE Body length (not including the tail) measures 23cm/ 9in long

PATTERN NOTES

. Use Cable Cast-on throughout

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

W+TK bring working yarn to the front of the work, slip next stitch purl-wise onto the RH needle, take working yarn to the back, slip the slipped stitch back onto the LH needle, turn the knitting = W+Tk (wrap and turn knit)

W+Tp take working yarn to the back of the work, slip next stitch knit-wise onto the RH needle, bring working yarn to the front, slip the slipped stitch back onto the LH needle, turn the knitting = W+Tp (wrap and turn purl)

GENERAL ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

p = purl

inc = increase

dec = decrease

k2tog/k3tog = knit two together/knit three together

p2tog/p3tog = purl two together/purl three together

RH/LH = right hand/ left hand RS/WS = right side/ wrong side

st/ sts =stitch/ stitches

skpo = slip one stitch, knit next stitch, pass slipped stitch over knit stitch to decrease by one stitch

kfb = knit into front then into back of stitch to increase by one stitch

pfb = Purl into front then knit into back of stitch to increase by one stitch

Short Row 2 K5, W+Tk

Short Row 3 P4, W+Tp

Short Row 4 K3, W+Tk

Short Row 5 P2, W+Tp

Short Row 6 K1, W+Tk

Short Row 7 P3, in yarn CD p11, in yarn CDE p12 to end of row

Work short rows to shape top of Puppy's Left Eye

Short Row 1 K12, W+Tk

Short Row 2 P5, W+Tp

Short Row 3 K4, W+Tk

Short Row 4 P3, W+Tp

Short Row 5 K2, W+Tk

Short Row 6 P1, W+Tp

Short Row 7 K3, in yarn CD k11, in yarn CDE k12 to end of row

Row 10 P11, in yarn CD p13, in yarn CDE p11 to end of row

Row 11 inc) K9, in yarn CD k2, kfb, k11, kfb, k2 in yarn CDE k9 to end

of row - 37sts

Row 12 P7, in yarn CD p23, in yarn CDE p7 to end of row

Cut yarn E, continue with yarn CD as follows:

Row 13 inc) K12, kfb, k11, kfb, k12 to end of row - 39sts

Work short rows to shape Forehead

Short Row 1 P33, W+Tp

Short Row 2 K27, W+Tk

Short Row 3 P26, W+Tp

Short Row 4 K25, W+Tk

Short Row 5 P24, W+Tp

Short Row 6 K23, W+Tk

Short Row 7 P22, W+Tp

Short Row 8 K21, W+Tk

Short Row 9 P20 W+Tp

Short Row 10 K19, W+Tk

Short Row 11 P18, W+Tp

Short Row 12 K17, W+Tk

Short Row 13 P16 W+Tp

Short Row 14 K15, W+Tk

Short Row 15 P27 to end of row

Row 14 dec) Cast off 7 sts for Left Side Head Back, knit next 24 sts, cast off last 7 sts for Right Side Head Back - 25 Head Back sts

WS facing rejoin yarn **CD** to 25 sts for Head Back, continue as follows:

Row 15 Purl PM at each end, on first and last stitch, for Left & Right

Ear Position Markers

Rows 16-22 Work 7 rows stocking stitch

Row 23 Purl all 25 Head Back stitches onto the circular needle for now and cut the yarn.

Before you carry on with the Head Top join the Muzzle Seam as follows on next page:

Join Muzzle Front Seam

With RS together, match the two Nose Seam Markers; then match the two Muzzle Front Markers. Work back stitch to join the small Muzzle Front Seam, joining both Muzzle Front Cast-On Edges, from the nose seam markers to the muzzle front markers Edge. *See Fig. 1, join dotted line A to B*

Turn out to RS. The Triangular Nose should lie on the right side, above the muzzle front seam. *See Fig. 2*

Remove both Nose Seam Markers (red markers)

Join Nose

Find the centre of the Nose Cast-On Edge then place it down over the Muzzle Front Seam so that the Nose Centre Point lies halfway along the muzzle front seam. Sew the nose down onto the Muzzle with a strand of mohair yarn. *See Fig. 3*




BODY

Joining Left Side of head: Left side of the puppy facing, begin at the stitch nearest to the Left Muzzle Marker, with yarn CDE pick up and knit 5 sts evenly along Left Cheek Row Ends to left-side corner of Head Back Seam Cast-Off Edge; from the 25 sts on the circular - knit across all 25sts:

- Joining Right Side of Head: Continue to pick up across the right side of the head, all onto the same needle as follows:

Pick up and knit 5 sts evenly along row ends from right corner of Head Back Seam Cast-Off Edge to Right Neck Marker. See Fig 4, pick up and knit from A to B; knit across from C to D; pick up and knit from E to F

Row 1 Purl all 35sts



Row 2 dec) K12, skpo, k7, k2tog, k12 to end of row - 33sts

Row 3 inc) Pfb, purl to last st, pfb - 35sts

Cut yarn **E**, continue with yarn **CD** as follows:

Row 4 inc) K12, kfb, k9, kfb, k12 to end of row - 37sts

Row 5 inc) Pfb, purl to last st, pfb - 39sts

Row 6 inc) Kfb, k14, kfb, k7, kfb, k14 to last st, kfb - 43sts

Row 7 Purl

Row 8 inc) K17, kfb, k7, kfb, k17 to end - 45sts

Row 9 Purl PM at each end of row for Left and Right Foreleg Markers

Join yarn E, continue with yarn **CDE**, changing to yarn **CD** as directed, as follows:

Left Foreleg

Work short rows to shape Left Foreleg Shoulder

Short Row 1 inc) Cast on 12 sts for Left Foreleg, k19, W+Tk

Short Row 2 P19

Short Row 3 K20, W+Tk

Short Row 4 P20

Row 10 K21 sts, in yarn CD knit 36 sts to end of row

Right Foreleg

Work short rows to shape Right Foreleg Shoulder

Short Row 1 inc) Cast on 12 sts for Right Foreleg, p19, W+Tp

Short Row 2 K19

Short Row 3 P20, W+Tp

Short Row 4 K20

Row 11 P49 sts, in yarn CDE p20 sts to end of row

Work short rows to shape Knee Bend in Left Foreleg

Short Row 1 K7, W+Tk

Short Row 2 P7

Short Row 3 K8, W+Tk

Short Row 4 P8

Short Row 5 K9, W+Tk

Short Row 6 P9

Row 12 dec) Cast off 6 sts for Left Paw PM for Left Knee Bend

Marker on last cast-off stitch, knit next 13 sts, in yarn CD knit 49 sts

to other side to work on Right Leg - 63sts

Cut yarn E - you won't be needing it for a while

Work short rows to shape Knee Bend in Right Foreleg

Short Row 1 P7, W+Tk

Short Row 2 K7

Short Row 3 P8, W+Tk

Short Row 4 K8

Short Row 5 P9, W+Tk

Short Row 6 K9

Row 13 dec) Cast off 6 sts purl-wise for Right Paw PM for Right

Knee Bend Marker on last cast-off stitch, purl to end of row - 57sts

Work short rows to shape Rear Left Foreleg Seam

Short Row 1 K14, W+Tk

Short Row 2 P6, W+Tp

Short Row 3 K5, W+Tk

Short Row 4 P6, W+Tp

Short Row 5 K5, W+Tk

Short Row 6 P12 to end of row

Row 14 Knit across all 57 sts to the end of row so you can work on

the Rear Right Foreleg Seam

Work short rows to shape Rear Right Foreleg Seam

Short Row 1 P14, W+Tp

Short Row 2 K6, W+Tk

Short Row 3 P5, W+Tp

Short Row 4 K6, W+Tk

Short Row 5 P5, W+Tp

Short Row 6 K12 to end of row

Row 15 Purl across all 57 sts to the end of row

Row 16 inc) Kfb, knit to last st, kfb - 59sts

Row 17 inc) Pfb, purl to last st, pfb - 61sts

Row 18 inc) Kfb, knit to last st, kfb - 63sts

Row 19 inc) Pfb, purl to last st, pfb - 65sts

PM at each end of last purl row for Left and Right Foreleg Seam

Markers

Inside	Left For	releg

Row 20 inc) Kfb, knit 11, Turn (flip work over so purl side faces)

Next Short Row P13 (NOTE: these are NOT wrap and turn rows

Next Short Row K13, Turn

Next Short Row P13

Next Short Row K13

Next Short Row P13

Cast off all 13 Left Inside Foreleg sts.

PM on last cast-off stitch for Left **Inner Foreleg Marker**.

Back to whole row:

Row 21 dec) Rejoin yarn CD, cast off 7 sts for Left Foreleg Seam,

knit across all remaining sts - 46sts

Inside Right Foreleg

Row 22 inc) Pfb, purl 11, Turn (flip work over so knit side faces)

Next Short Row K13

Next Short Row P13, Turn

Next Short Row K13

Next Short Row P13

Next Short Row K13

Cast off all 13 Right Inside Foreleg sts purl-wise.

PM on last cast-off stitch for Right **Inner Foreleg Marker**.

Back to whole row:

Row 22 dec) Rejoin yarn CD, cast off 7 sts purl-wise for Right

Foreleg Seam, purl across all remaining sts - 27sts

Foreleg Seams

Row 23 inc) Cast on 8 sts for Left Foreleg Seam, knit to end.

Row 24 inc) Cast on 8 sts for Right Foreleg Seam, purl to end - 43sts

Row 25-26 Work 2 rows stocking stitch

Row 27 dec) K8, skpo, k23, k2tog, k8 to end of row - 41sts

Row 28 dec) P2tog, purl to last 2 sts, p2tog - 39sts

Work short rows to shape **Back** as follows:

Short Row 1 K38, W+Tk

Short Row 2 P37, W+Tp

Short Row 3 K36, W+Tk

Short Row 4 P35, W+Tp

Short Row 5 K34, W+Tk

Short Row 6 P33, W+Tp

Short Row 7 K32, W+Tk

Short Row 8 P31, W+Tp

Short Row 9 K30, W+Tk

Short Row 10 P29, W+Tp

Short Row 11 K28, W+Tk

Short Row 12 P27, W+Tp

Short Row 13 K26, W+Tk

Short Row 14 P25, W+Tp

Short Row 15 K32 across to the end of row

Row 29 Purl all 39 sts

Left Hind Leg Short Row 7 P6, W+Tp

Row 30 inc) Cast on 5 sts, PM for Left Hind Leg, k13, skpo, k19, k2tog, k8 Short Row 8 K7, W+Tk

to end - 42sts Short Row 9 P8, W+Tp

Right Hind Leg Short Row 10 K9, W+Tk

Row 31 inc) Cast on 5 sts, PM for Right Hind Leg, purl to end - 47sts Short Row 11 Purl to end

Work short rows to shape **Left Hind Leg** as follows: Continue with **Back Shaping** as follows:

Short Row 2 P1, W+Tp Row 33 Purl

Short Row 3 K2, W+Tk

Row 34 dec) K2tog, k13, skpo, k7, k2tog, k13, k2tog - 37sts

Short Row 4 P3, W+Tp Row 35 Purl

Short Row 5 K4, W+Tk

Row 36 dec) K13, skpo, k7, k2tog, knit to end - 35sts

Short Row 6 P5, W+Tp Row 37 Purl

Short Row 7 K6, W+Tk

Row 38 dec) K2tog, k10, skpo, k7, k2tog, k10, k2tog - 31sts

Short Row 8 P7, W+Tp Row 39 Purl

Short Row 9 K8, W+Tk

Row 40 dec) K10, skpo, k7, k2tog, knit to end - 29sts

Short Row 10 P9, W+Tp Row 41 Purl all 29 Back sts onto the circular knitting needle.

Short Row 11 dec) K15, skpo, k11, k2tog, k16 to end - 45sts Cut all yarn.

Work short rows to shape **Right Hind Leg** as follows: LEFT HIND LEG

Short Row 1 P6, W+Tp RS facing, beginning at puppy's Left Hind Leg Marker, with yarn **CD**,

Short Row 2 K1, W+Tk pick up and knit 6 sts across row ends to the stitches on the circular

Short Row 3 P2, W+Tp needle; then knit across the first 10 sts from the circular. See Figs. 5 &

Short Row 4 K3, W+Tk 6, pick up from A to B as dotted line; then knit along to C, as dotted line

Short Row 5 P4, W+Tp -16sts **NOTE**: The remaining stitches are kept on the circular as you

Short Row 6 K5, W+Tk work the 16 sts from Left Hind Leg as follows:

Rows 1, 3 & 5 Purl

Row 2 dec) [k1, k2tog] four times, k4 to end - 12sts

Row 4 dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 10sts

Row 6 inc) Cast on 12 sts for Left Paw, k22 - 22 Left Hind Leg sts

Row 7 Purl PM for Left Rear End Marker on first stitch

Short rows to shape the Foot Pad Side 1

Short row 1 inc) Kfb, k9, W+Tk

Short row 2 P11

Short row 3 K10, W+Tk

Short row 4 P10

Short row 5 K9, W+Tk

Short row 6 P9

Short row 7 K8, W+Tk

Short row 8 P8

Short row 9 K7, W+Tk

Short row 10 P7

Row 8 dec) K2tog twice, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 20sts

Rows 9-10 Beginning with a purl row work two rows stocking stitch

Row 11 dec) Cast off 11 sts purl-wise for Left Heel, purl to end - 9sts

Left Paw Front

Row 12 dec) K2tog twice, knit to end of row - 7sts

Row 13 Purl

Row 14 dec) *K2tog, cast off 1** repeat from * to ** all along, fasten off last stitch for Left Paw Front Edge.

RIGHT HIND LEG

RS facing, rejoin yarn **CD** to the 19 sts on the circular needle, continue as follows:

Row 1 inc) K19 then pick up and knit 6 sts across row ends to puppy's Right Hind Leg Marker - 25sts

Row 2 P16, Turn so knit side faces

(NOTE: the remaining 9 Tail sts can either remain on the needle or be slipped onto the circular needle if you find it easier)

Row 3 dec) K4, [k2tog, k1] - 12 Right Hind Leg sts

Row 4 P12, Turn so knit side faces

Row 5 dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 10sts

Row 6 inc) Cast on 12 sts for Right Paw, p22 - 22 Right Hind Leg sts

Row 7 Knit PM for Right Rear End Marker on first stitch

Right Paw

Short rows to shape the Foot Pad Side 1

Short row 1 inc) Pfb, p9, W+Tp

Short row 2 K11

Short row 3 P10, W+Tp

Short row 4 K10

Short row 5 P9, W+Tp

Short row 6 K9

Short row 7 P8, W+Tp

Short row 8 K8

Short row 9 P7, W+Tp

Short row 10 K7

Row 8 dec) P2tog twice, p17, p2tog - 20sts

Rows 9-10 Work two rows stocking stitch

Row 11 dec) Cast off 11 sts for Right Heel, knit to end - 9sts

Right Paw Front

Row 12 dec) P2tog twice, p5 - 6sts

Row 13 Knit

Row 14 dec) *P2tog, cast off 1 purl-wise**, repeat from * to ** three times, fasten off last stitch for Right Paw Front Edge.

TAIL

WS facing, rejoin yarn CD to the 9 Tail sts

Row 1 inc) Cast on 4 sts for Tail Base, p13 across - 13 Tail sts

Row 2 inc) Cast on 4 sts, for Tail Base, k17 across - 17 Tail sts

Rows 3-5 Beginning with a purl row work 3 rows stocking stitch

Row 6 dec) K3, skpo, k7, k2tog, k3 - 15sts

Rows 7-9 Beginning with a purl row work 3 rows stocking stitch

Row 10 dec) K3, skpo, k5, k2tog, k3 - 13sts

Rows 11-13 Beginning with a purl row work 3 rows stocking stitch

Row 14 dec) K3, skpo, k3, k2tog, k3 - 11sts

Rows 15-17 Beginning with a purl row work 3 rows stocking stitch

Row 18 dec) K3, skpo, k1, k2tog, k3 - 9sts

Row 19 Purl

Work short rows to shape **Tail Tip** as follows:

Short Row 1 K8, W+Tk

Short Row 2 P7, W+Tp

Short Row 3 K6, W+Tk

Short Row 4 P5, W+Tp

Short Row 5 K4, W+Tk

Short Row 6 P3, W+Tp

Short Row 7 K2, W+Tk

Short Row 8 P1, W+Tp

Short Row 9 K5 to end of row

Row 20 dec) P2tog, p1, p3tog, p1, p2tog - 5sts

Cast off all 5 Tail Point sts.



Join Tail Seam

Fold the Tail Point Cast-Off Edge in half with WS together and mattress stitch the two halves together.

Continue to mattress stitch the row ends from the Tail Tip Seam along to the corners of the cast-on edges at the Tail Base.

- See. Fig. 7

The Tail is lightly stuffed. Leave the cast-on edges un-sewn - it's across these you will pick up sts for the Belly as follows:



BELLY

RS and puppy's Back facing you (and with tail lying against the back to keep it out of the way), with yarn **B**, begin at puppy's Left Rear End Marker pick up and knit 7 sts across Left Rear End Row End to the split near the Tail; pick up and knit 6 sts across Tail Base Cast-On Edges (*3 stitches either side of the Tail Seam you've just sewn*); pick up and knit 7 sts across Right Rear End Row ends from the split near the tail to puppy's Right Rear End Marker. - *See Fig. 8, pick up from A to B; B to C; C to D* - 20 Belly sts

BELLY continued

Row 1 dec) P2tog, purl to last 2 sts, p2tog - 18sts

Row 2 dec) K5, skpo, k4, k2tog, knit to end - 16sts

Row 3 Purl

Row 4 dec) K4, skpo, k4, k2tog, knit to end - 14sts

Rows 5-11 Beginning with a purl row work 7 rows stocking stitch

Row 12 inc) K4, kfb, k4, kfb, knit to end - 16sts

Row 13 Purl

Row 14 inc) K5, kfb, k4, kfb, knit to end - 18sts

Row 15 Purl

Row 16 inc) K6, kfb, k4, kfb, knit to end - 20sts

Row 17 Purl

Row 18 inc) K7, kfb, k4, kfb, knit to end - 22sts

PM at each end of last row for Belly to Thigh Markers

Row 19 Purl

Work short rows to shape **Belly** as follows:

Short Row 1 K21, W+Tk

Short Row 2 P20, W+Tp

Short Row 3 K19, W+Tk

Short Row 4 P18, W+Tp

Short Row 5 K17, W+Tk

Short Row 6 P16, W+Tp

Short Row 7 K19 to end of row

Rows 20-22 Beginning with a purl row work 3 rows stocking stitch

Cut yarn B, join yarn CD, continue with yarn CD as follows:

Row 23 dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 20sts

Rows 24-26 Beginning with a purl row work 3 rows stocking stitch

Row 27 dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 18sts

Rows 28 & 30 dec) Purl

Row 29 dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 16sts

Row 31 dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 14sts

Rows 32-33 Beginning with a purl row work 2 rows stocking stitch

PM at each end of last knit row for Under Foreleg Markers

Rows 34-40 Beginning with a purl row work 7 rows stocking stitch

PM at each end of last purl row for Breast Markers

Work short rows to shape **Breast** as follows:

Short Row 1 dec) K1, k2tog, k8, k2tog, W+Tk

Short Row 2 P10, W+Tp

Short Row 3 dec) K1, k2tog, k4, k2tog, W+Tk

Short Row 4 P6, W+Tp

Short Row 5 K5, W+Tk

Short Row 6 P4, W+Tp

Short Row 7 K7 to end of row

Row 41 Purl all 10 Throat sts

Rows 42-45 Work 4 rows stocking stitch

Cast off all 10 Throat sts PM at each end for Throat Markers

Chin

Return to the Throat Cast-Off Edge, RS facing, with yarn **CD** pick up and knit 10 sts across the cast-off edge puppy's Left (on your right)

Throat Marker to puppy's Right Throat Marker. - See Fig. 9, pick up from A to B)

Rows 1-4 Beginning with a purl row work 4 rows stocking stitch

Work short rows to shape Bottom Jaw

Short Row 1 P9, W+Tp

Short Row 2 K8, W+Tk

Short Row 3 P7, W+Tp

Short Row 4 K6, W+Tk

Short Row 5 P8 to end of row

Row 5 dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog – 8sts

Row 6 dec) *P2tog, cast off 1 purl-wise**, repeat from * to ** twice more, cast off last 2 stitches purl-wise for Lower Jaw Cast-Off Edge.



Join Chin and Bottom Jaw to Front Muzzle and Upper Jaw

Find the centre of the Lower Jaw Cast-Off Edge (mark with a pin if you like). WS together, match this centre point with the Nose Seam at the Muzzle Front Markers; match the Throat Markers to the Muzzle Markers then, working on one side at a time neatly join the lower jaw cast-off edge and chin row ends to the muzzle upper jaw from muzzle front markers to throat/ muzzle markers, you'll need to ease the seam together as the chin rows are more than the upper jaw/ muzzle markers. - See Fig. 10, join dotted lines for Left Side Remove Muzzle Front Markers and Muzzle Markers



Join Front to Neck

Working on one side at a time, with WS together, match the Throat Marker with the Chin Marker, then match the Foreleg Marker with the Breast Marker, ease seam together and work mattress stitch to join the Neck/ Back row ends to the Front/ Throat row ends in between the two sets of markers. - See Fig. 11, join dotted lines for Left Front/ Neck

Remove Throat markers and Breast Markers

Join Foreleg Seam

Working on one side at a time, find Foreleg Seam Cast-Off and Cast-On Edges. - See Fig. 12

With RS together, match the two edges together and join both edges together with back-stitch ti create a crease that will lie beneath the foreleg. Turn out to RS.





Join Knee-Bend Seam

Working on one side at a time, find Knee-Bend Cast-Off Edge and Knee Bend Marker. - See Fig. 13

With WS together, match the Foreleg Seam Marker to the corner of the Knee-Bend Cast-Off Edge and mattress stitch from foreleg seam marker/ corner of knee-bend cast-off edge along to the split at the knee-bend marker, so joining knee-bend cast-off edge to foreleg row ends. - See Fig. 13, join dotted lines

Remove Foreleg Seam Markers and Knee-Bend Markers



Join Belly to Back

Working on one side at a time, with WS together, match the Under Foreleg Marker to the end of the Foreleg Seam; match the Belly to Thigh Marker to the Hind Leg Marker. - See Fig. 14

Work mattress stitch to join in between those 2 sets of markers so joining the belly row end to the back row ends and thigh cast on edge. - See Fig. 14

Remove Hind Leg Markers.

Before you work on the Inner Hind Legs stuff all of your yarn endings inside the body to get them out of the way.

Then with toy filling stuff the head, belly and back of the body, taking care to fill the parts where there is shaping to enhance those shaped areas.

INNER HIND LEGS

Left Inner Hind leg

Return to the Belly on puppy's Left Side.

RS and belly facing you, Tail to your right beginning at puppy's Left Rear End Marker, (*on your right*) with yarn **CD** pick up and knit 14 sts across Belly row ends to Left Belly to Thigh Marker. - *See Fig. 15, pick up and knit as dotted line from A to B*

Rows 1-5 Beginning with a purl row work 5 rows stocking stitch

Row 6 dec) K2tog, knit to end of row - 13sts

Row 7 inc) Cast on 8 sts for Left Inner Paw, purl all 21 sts to end of row

Rows 8-9 Work 2 rows stocking stitch

Row 10 inc) Knit to last st, kfb - 22sts

Row 11 Purl

Row 12 dec) Cast off 10 sts for Left Inner Heel, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 11 Left Paw sts

Rows 13-17 Beginning with a purl row work 5 rows stocking stitch

Row 18 dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 9sts

Row 19 dec) P2tog, purl to last 2 sts, p2tog - 7sts

Cast off all 7 Left Inner Paw sts.

Join Inner Hind Leg and Paw to Outer Hind Leg and Paw

Working on one Hind Leg at a time - Ref. Fig. 16:

- WS together, Match the Paw Cast-On Edge with Inner Paw Cast-On Edge, ease together and mattress sew both edges.
- **2.** WS together, Match the Heel Cast-Off Edge with Inner Heel Cast-Off Edge, ease together and mattress sew both edges.
- **3.** Match the Heel Row ends to Inner Heel Row ends and ease together before mattress stitching the two sets of row ends for the Heel Seam to the Rear End Marker. *Join 2 dotted lines together*

Remove Rear End Marker

- **4.** WS together, Match the Paw Cast-Off Edge with Inner Paw Cast-Off Edge, ease together and mattress sew both edges.
- **5.** Stuff all your yarn ends plus a little toy filling into the front of the leg and paw.
- **6.** Mattress stitch to join the seam at the front of the leg from the paw seam at the top of the paw (*where you joined the paw and paw inner cast-on edges*) to the Belly to Thigh Marker.

Remove Belly to Thigh Marker

7. Stuff the paw some more, if needs be, before easing the two row end edges at the front of the paw and joining with mattress stitch. Then finish by joining the last tiny seam at the bottom of the paw with mattress stitch.

Right Inner Hind leg

Return to the Belly on puppy's Right Side.

RS and belly facing you, Tail to your left beginning at Belly to Thigh Marker with yarn **CD** pick up and knit 14 sts across Belly row ends to Rear End Marker. - See Fig. 15, pick up and knit as dotted line from C to D

Rows 1-5 Beginning with a purl row work 5 rows stocking stitch

Row 6 inc) Cast on 8 sts for Right Inner Paw, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog

- 21sts

Rows 7-9 Beginning with a purl row work 3 rows stocking stitch

Row 10 inc) Kfb, knit to end of row - 22sts

Row 11 dec) Cast off 10 sts purl-wise for Right Inner Heel, purl to end of row - 12sts

Row 12 dec) K2tog, knit to end of row - 11sts

Rows 13-17 Beginning with a purl row work 5 rows stocking stitch

Row 18 dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 9sts

Row 19 dec) P2tog, purl to last 2 sts, p2tog - 7sts

Cast off all 7 Left Inner Paw sts.

Finishing Paw Touches

With yarn F work paw indents by sewing straight stitches over the ends of the paws and drawing the stitches tightly to create dips in the ends of the paws. - See Fig. 17

FORELEG PAWS - Left Paw

Return to the row ends and the end of the Foreleg Bend Seam at the Left Foreleg.

RS facing, beginning at your right corner at the Left Foreleg Cast-On Edge, with yarn **CD** pick up and knit 15 sts across the row ends and across the bottom of the foreleg bend seam to the corner of the Left Inside Foreleg Cast-Off Edge. - See Fig. 18, pick up and knit from A to B

Row 2 inc) Kfb, knit to last st, kfb - 19sts

Row 3 Purl

Short rows to shape the Foot Pad Side 1

Short row 1 inc) Kfb, k8, W+Tk

Short row 2 P10

Short row 3 K9, W+Tk

Short row 4 P9

Short row 5 K8, W+Tk

Short row 6 P8

Short row 7 K7, W+Tk

Short row 8 P7

Row 4 Knit across all 20 sts

Short rows to shape the Foot Pad Side 2

Short row 1 inc) Pfb, p8, W+Tp

Short row 2 K10

Short row 3 P9, W+Tp

Short row 4 K9

Short row 5 P8, W+Tp

Short row 6 K8

Short row 7 P7, W+Tp

Short row 8 K7

Row 5 dec) P2tog twice, purl to last 4 sts, p2tog twice - 17sts

Cast off all 17 Paw Sole sts**.

Right Paw

Return to the row ends at the Right Foreleg.

RS facing, beginning at your right corner at the Right Inside Foreleg Cast-Off Edge, with yarn **CD** pick up and knit 15 sts across the row ends and across the bottom of the foreleg bend seam to the corner of the Right Foreleg Cast-On Edge.

Work as Left Foot from * to **

Join Paw and Foreleg Seam

WS together, fold the cast-off edge and mattress stitch both halves together for the Paw Pad.

Match the Foreleg Marker with the Inner Foreleg Marker and continue to work mattress to join along the front of the foreleg to the cast-on edge. - See Fig. 19

Stuff the leg and paw through the top of the foreleg` Remove Inner Foreleg Marker.

Finishing Paw Touches

With yarn F work paw indents by sewing straight stitches over the ends of the paws and drawing the stitches tightly to create dips in the ends of the paws. - See Fig. 17

Join Under-Foreleg Seam

Lift up the stuffed foreleg and mattress stitch to join the inside of the foreleg to the breast from Foreleg Marker to Under Foreleg Marker.

- See Fig. 20 joining from A to B

Remove both markers

EYES

Return to the Upper Eyes and Lower Eyes short rows shaping.

Working on one eye at a time push the toy eye into the centre of the two shaped upper and lower eye lids and secure the eye in place with the backing. - See Figs. 21 & 22

Work a little stuffing into the eye lid shaping to enhance the shape and to make the eyes 'sleepy' looking. - See Fig. 23

Join Head Back Seams

NOTE: These are your last seams, your last chance to add more stuffing if needs be:

To complete the head seams, working on one side at a time, mattress the open seams at the head back near the Ear Position Markers. - See Fig. 24, join dotted lines A to B



EARS

The Ears are knitted independently and then sewn onto the head once knitted as follows:

Work both Ears similarly

With yarn **DE** or **CD** cast on 7 sts

Row 1 Purl

Row 2 inc) Kfb, knit to last st, kfb - 9sts

Rows 3-4 inc) Repeat last 2 rows once - 11sts

Row 5 Purl

Row 6 dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 9sts

Row 7 Purl

Rows 8-11 inc) Repeat last 2 rows twice - 5sts

Row 12 dec) K2tog, k1, k2tog - 3sts

Row 13 dec) P3tog

Fasten off for Ear Point.

Weave tail ends along ear edge.

Join Ears to the Head

Working on one ear at a time, WS together match the fastened-off Ear Point to the Ear Position Marker and sew in place with a few stitches.

Then allow the ear to bend forwards a little and join the Ear Cast-On

Edge to the head in a slight curve. - See Figs. 25 & 26

Remove Ear Position Markers

Finishing Facial Touches

- **1.** Push the nose back into the Muzzle a little and secure with a couple of discreet stitches behind the ears. See Fig. 27
- 2. Work an upside down 'T' across the mouth with a single length yarn
- F. See Fig. 28
- **3.** If you wish, with yarn F, work a few duplicate stitches for little markings. See Fig. 29

A Note About Stuffing

You'll see from the photos and the little Reel I did on @dotpebbles knitS

Instagram that there is not loads of stuffing in and around the head and the body,
just enough to enhance the shaping but not so much as to distort the knitting.

Because it's a puppy she'll need loose flesh to grow into!! - See Fig. 30
